



## Notes

- 1 In the summary, some details are combined (e.g. forename and surname) to make them more natural to read by users.
- 2 Clicking on the 'Edit' button will make that particular section editable by the user (As seen in **Point 6** below).
- 3 At the bottom of the page there is a convenient 'Edit All' button that will make all the sections editable.
- 4 The 'Edit All' button becomes a 'Save All' button when a user starts editing a section. This allows the user to conveniently save all edited sections using one button.
- 5 When a section is being edited, the 'Edit' button is changed to an 'Editing' label which is not clickable.
- 6 When a section is being edited the relevant form controls replace the original summary information.
- 7 Each section being edited has it's own save button, and a cancel button in case the user changes their mind.
- 8 At the bottom of the page there is a convenient 'Save All' button, which saves all sections being edited.
